1) We Have A King

Jhn 18:37 Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?"

Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

1Ti 6:15 which He will manifest in His own time, He who is the blessed and only Potentate, <mark>the King of kings</mark> and Lord of lords,

Mat 19:24 "And again I say to you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." Mat 21:31 "Which of the two did the will of his father?"

They said to Him, "The first." Jesus said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that tax collectors and harlots enter the kingdom of God before you.

Mat 21:43 "Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it.

Mar 1:14

Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom

	of God,
<u>Mar 1:15</u>	and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."
Mar 4:11	And He said to them, "To you it has been given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God; but to those who are outside, all things come in parables,
Mar 4:26	And He said, "The

kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground,

<u>Mar 4:30</u>

Then He said, "To what shall we liken the kingdom of God? Or with what parable shall we picture it?

Mar 9:1

And He said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that there are some standing here who will not taste death till they see the kingdom of God present with power."

"And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire-

Mar 14:25 "Assuredly, I say to you, I will no longer drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God."

Mar 15:43 Joseph of Arimathea, a prominent council member, who was himself waiting for the kingdom of God, coming and taking courage, went in to Pilate and asked for the body of

	Jesus.
Luk 4:43	but He said to them, "I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent."
<u>Luk 6:20</u>	Then He lifted up His eyes toward His disciples, and said: "Blessed are you poor, For yours is the kingdom of God.
<u>Luk 7:28</u>	"For I say to you,

among those born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist; but he who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he."

<u> Luk 8:1</u>

Now it came to pass, afterward, that He went through every city and village, preaching and bringing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God. And the twelve were with Him,

Luk 8:10	And He said, "To you it has been given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God, but to the rest it is given in parables, that

Luk 12:31 "But seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you. Luk 13:18 Then He said, "What is the kingdom of God like? And to what shall I compare it?

Luk 13:20 And again He said, "To what shall I liken the kingdom of God?

Luk 18:24 And when Jesus saw that he became very sorrowful, He said, "How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God! Luk 18:25 "For it is easier for a camel to go through the

eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."

Luk 18:29 So He said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or parents or brothers or wife or children, for the sake of the kingdom of God,

Luk 19:11 Now as they heard these things, He spoke another parable, because He was near Jerusalem and because

they thought the kingdom of God would appear immediately. Luk 21:31 "So you also, when you see these things happening, know that the kingdom of God is near. Luk 22:16 "for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." Luk 22:18 "for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the

kingdom of God comes."

Luk 23:51 He had not consented to their decision and deed. He was from Arimathea, a city of the Jews, who himself was also waiting for the kingdom of God.

Jhn 3:3

Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Jhn 3:5

Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

Act 1:3

to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

Act 8:12

But when they believed Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized.

Act 14:22 strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting them to continue in the faith, and saying, "We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God."

Act 19:8

And he went into the synagogue and spoke boldly for three months, reasoning and persuading concerning the things of the kingdom of God.

Act 20:25 "And indeed, now I know that you all, among whom I have gone preaching the kingdom of God, will see my face no more.

Act 28:23 So when they had appointed him a day, many came to him at

his lodging, to whom he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening.

Act 28:31 preaching the kingdom of God and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him.

1Co 6:10	nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.
1Co 15:50	Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption.
□ Gal 5:21	envy, murders,

drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.
